## 1. COMPETITION DETAILS

1.1 The U-21 Dressage Championship for age riders (athletes) from 12 years to 21 years old (from the 1<sup>st</sup> January of which they reach their 12th birthday to 31<sup>st</sup> December of which they reach their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday) is held from September to the dates of the Final Competition in accordance with the FEI Dressage, FEI General Regulations, and Veterinary Regulations currently in force.

1.2 The Final Competition on Borrowed Horses: –

The event is only for the best 3 riders from zone ranking list and 3 riders from the hosting NF (the Organizer of the Final Competition). The number of best riders from zone ranking list is subject to change, based on the numbers of borrowed horses available and participating NFs, if necessary. The final competition is a two-round competition with different horses provided in each round.

1.3 The OC in the Final Competition is responsible for the inland travelling expenses of foreign participants including Officials, Chefs d'Equipe (one only per NF) and Athletes, as well as the accommodation (board and lodging) during the competition.

1.4 The Final Competition will be held at Doha, Qatar on November 2018 (the dates are subject to change).

1.6 In the Championship, "Athletes Living outside their country of nationality" (as defined in the FEI General Regulations) cannot compete for their country of residence.

1.7 The Championship Competition is open to all horses of any origin provided they have successfully passed the Veterinary Inspection. Horses may compete if they are a minimum of 5 years of age.

## 2. HEADGEAR, DRESS & SADDLERY

2.1 Protective Headgear: according to Art. 427.1 dressage rules Protective Headgear has to be worn by all Athletes (as well as any other person) at all times while mounted and by U-25 for the horse inspection. Any athlete (as well as any other person) violating this provision must immediately be prohibited from further riding until the Protective Headgear is properly in place. Only Protective Headgear is allowed to wear in the Championship

2.2 Dress: according to Art. 427.2 A black or dark blue jacket or tail coat, white or off-white breeches, stock or tie, gloves, and black riding boots must be worn.

2.3 Saddlery must be as laid down in Art. 428 of the FEI Dressage Rules. An ordinary snaffle **must** be used. A double bridle is only allowed under the authority of the Ground Jury. This applies in the practice and competition arenas.

Whip: According to Art. 428.3, it is forbidden to carry a whip of any kind while competing in the arena. However, the use of one whip, with a total maximum length of 120 cm in the practice area is allowed. The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena or the athlete will entail a penalty. See Art 430 of the FEI Dressage Rules.

Spurs: Spurs are optional but if used, only blunt metal spurs no longer than three and half centimetre (3.5cm) are allowed.

Gadgets: According to Art. 428.4, martingales, breast plates, bit guards, any kind of gadgets (such as bearing, side, running or balancing reins, nasal strips etc.), and any form of blinkers are under penalty of elimination and strictly forbidden. See Article 430 of the Dressage Rules.

### 3. THE CLASSIFICATION

3.1 Only one ranking list will be established and will count towards the final classification.

3.2 **The Classification** in each NF of the Zone is decided as follows: the winner is the athlete having the highest total points converted into percentage, the second the one with the next highest total and so on. **In case of equality of points** for the first, second and/or third places **in a NF**, the higher collective marks will be decisive for the placing. If a further tie exists, the higher percentage from Judge C will be decisive. In case of equality of points for places other than the first three, the Athletes concerned are given the same rank. These also apply in the Zone Ranking as well as the Final Competition.

3.3 The classification for the Final Competition will be decided by adding together the percentage scores attained in the Competition 1 and Competition 2. The rider with the highest total percentage scores will be declared as the winner, and so on. In the event of a tie for the top three placing, please refer to Article 3.2.

3.4 The zone is divided as follows: –

**Zone 1** : Kyrgyzstan, Singapore, Malaysia and India

Best ranking of Zone 1 : Number of finalists (7)

**Zone 2** : Indonesia, Thailand and Chinese Taipei

Best ranking of Zone 2 : Number of finalists (5)

#### **4. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COMPETITION**

##### 4.1 Rules of Competition

The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of Equestrian Australia and Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM).

##### 4.2 Prize Giving Ceremony

4.2.1 Placed riders that do not attend the prize giving ceremony will not receive their prizes.

4.2.2 All riders must be mounted during prize giving.

##### 4.3 In House–Rules

4.3.1 All riders are expected to wear a correctly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and shirt at all times when mounted.

4.3.2 The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.

4.3.3 Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only not inside the stables.

4.3.4 You are provided with bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse. The dung / waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in the correct manner.

4.3.5 Stabling is limited and will be on a first paid first served basis. All stabling must be left in a clean tidy state otherwise a charge will be levied.

##### 4.4 The Organizer Reserves the Right to Bill

4.4.1 Any participating club the cost of cleaning stables.

4.4.2 Alter advertised times if necessary. Cancel any event or class. Divide any class.

##### 4.5 Competition Ground: Sand

#### 4.6 Veterinary Scratching

Entries cancelled after the Entries closing Date must be verified with a Vet. Medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.

#### 4.7 Entry Fees

4.7.1 All entry fees must be paid prior to the start the competition double.

4.7.2 Late entry will be charged an extra 50%.

4.7.3 No refund will be made to the rider if cancel the entry without Veterinary Medical Certificate.

#### 4.8 Stabling

RM 100.00 per horse per day for a non-air-conditioned stall. Allocation will be made on a first-come-first-served basis

#### 4.9 Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms

Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete.

#### 4.10 Horse Numbers

Horse Identification Numbers (Bridle Numbers) will be distributed at the Secretariat to riders for a refundable deposit of RM20.00. This deposit will be forfeited if you lose or damage your number. Kindly ensure your horse is wearing its number during your stay with us for easy identification.
